


SCHOLAR



Dr. King enjoyed playing pool regularly as a student at Crozer Theological Seminary. According to classmates he was really good.






Dr. King was an amazing writer. He authored several books, articles, speeches, sermons, and the like.








Dr. King prided himself on being a down to earth and approachable "regular" person. In September of 1967 he rode a bike on Fire Island, NY

Dr. King was arrested 29 times mostly during acts of civil disobedience or on trumped up charges to discourage his activism and leadership.




COMEDIAN
